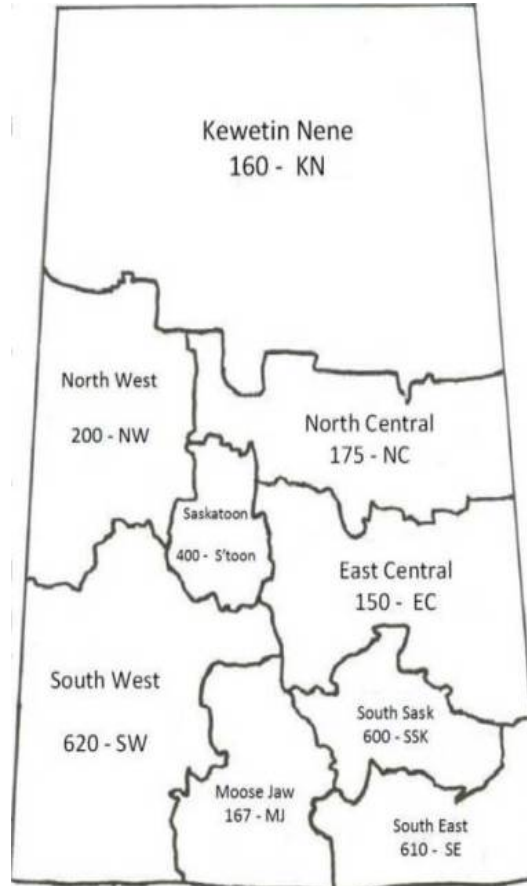

#### ***Annual Reading Conference***

The annual reading conference hosted by the Saskatchewan Reading Council features well known authors, guest speakers, local presenters and exhibitors to showcase literacy instruction and new best practices. As a member of **KNRC**, you receive a reduced conference rate.

#### ***Read to Me***

Literacy Packages are distributed across the province to mothers of newborn babies during a designated week each spring. KNRC provides the book bags to teen parent programs and to prenatal programs. Each year we try to partner with an organization that is north-wide and fulfills our mandate.

#### ***Kewetin Nene RC Programs***

KNRC plans an array of events for our communities each year. Programs include: gathering and distributing books to those in need, Young Writers' celebrations and workshops, author visits, reading carnivals, contests, literacy day celebrations and more!

#### ***Query***

Each year members receive two issues of the professional journal *Query*. *Query* features many literacy related articles and ideas from local to international perspectives. KNRC events and news are also featured in the journal.

#### ***Young Saskatchewan Writers' Publication***

This is an annual publication of Saskatchewan K-12 student writing. Student writers submit in January; those selected will have their work published. Each writer selected and KNRC members receive a copy in the Spring.
